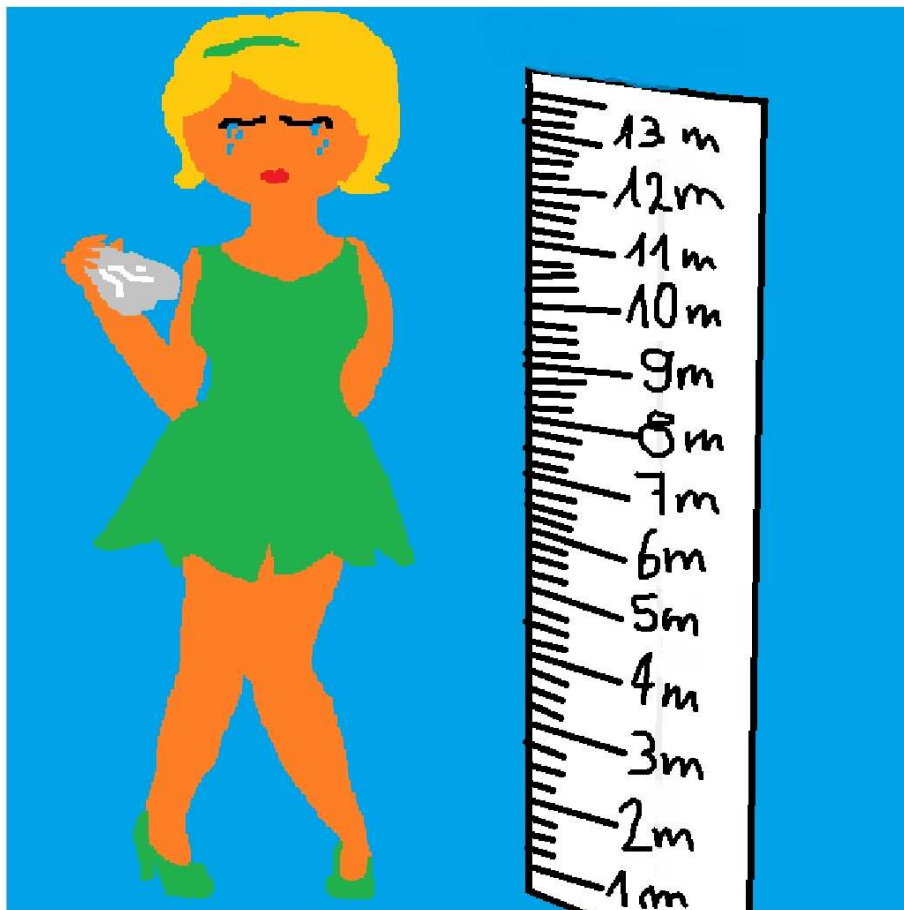


Giantelina
