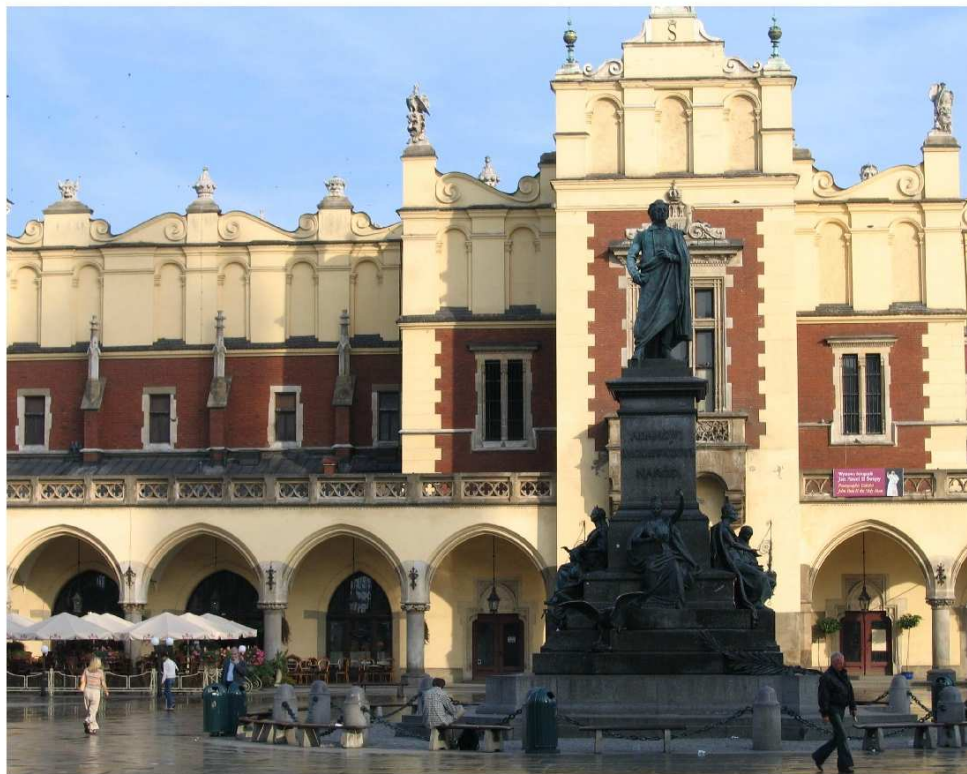
I'm Julia. I'm nearly 11. I like horses and computer games.

The Main Market Square

There is a Main Market Square in Cracow. It is about 755 years old. There are 11 streets near it. It is big, regular and square. It is the biggest square in Cracow and one of the biggest in Europe.

The Cloth Hall (Sukiennice)

There is a Cloth Hall in Cracow. It was built by the king Bolesław Wstydlivy.

It is located in the middle of the Main Market Square. You can buy jewelry and hand craft there. You can find there nice souvenirs from Cracow.

Town Hall Tower

The Tower is the only remaining part of the old Town Hall demolished in 1820. The cellars once housed a city prison with a Medieval torture chamber. In front of the Town Hall Tower there are two monuments of lions. It is big and beautiful.

ST. Mary's Basilica

There is St. Mary's Basilica in Cracow. It is nine centuries old. It has got two towers and a beautiful altar made by Wit Stwoszcz. Every hour you can hear the The Heynal

(the Cracovian Hymn). It is played by a trumpeter four times from the highest tower of St. Mary's Church. The church is in the Main Market Square. It is very interesting.

Wawel - The Royal Castle

It is a very old castle located on the banks of the River Vistula (Wisła). There used to live princesses, kings, queens in the old times. The tourists can visit State Rooms, Royal Private Apartments, Exhibition "The Lost Wawel", Exhibition "Oriental Art", The Royal Gardens and Dragon's Den.



The Scary Dragon's Den

The Dragon's Den, a legendary cave in the western slope of Wawel Hill, it is surely among great curiosities of Wawel. In the oldest version of legend about the dragon of Wawel - the monster used to eat young women.

There is a beautiful Park in Prokocim.

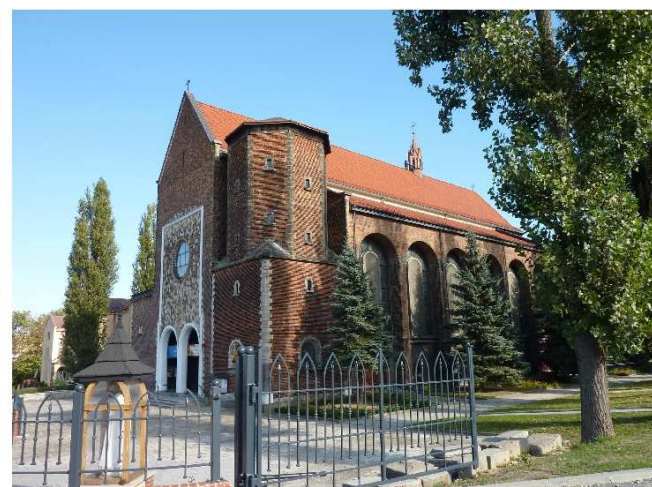
There is also a palace where Erazm Jerzmanowski,
